
Required Action: Declare a temporary Burning Ban in the LGD.

Background Information:

- Manitoba is experiencing hot dry weather, and the threat of wildfires is a serious concern in the northern region
- Municipalities throughout the Province are declaring burning bans to minimize the risk of wildfires
- The Administrator in consultation with Northern and Municipal Relations developed a burning ban by-law for the LGD – By-law No. 687-25
- In accordance with clause 3 of By-law No. 687-25, the Administrator “may ban all burning (bonfires, campfires, barbeques and outdoor fires) in the LGD if conditions exist where, in the opinion of the Administrator, fires are of extremely high risk and such a ban would prevent wildfires from occurring”

DECISION

The Administrator, pursuant to clause 3 of the LGD’s Burning ban By-law No. 687-25, declares that a temporary burning ban is in effective in the LGD.
