

LGD OF MYSTERY LAKE

Date: September 4, 2025

Required Action: Revoke the temporary Burning Ban in the LGD.

Background Information:

- During June, Northern Manitoba experienced hot dry weather and on July 4, 2025 wildfire no061 was detected within the LGD, 6km from the City of Thompson
- Municipalities throughout the Province declared burning bans to minimize/prevent wildfires
- On June 13, 2025 the LGD declared a burning ban, in accordance with clause 3 of its By-law No. 687-25 (Burning Ban), which states, "the Administrator may ban all burning (bonfires, campfires, barbeques and outdoor fires) in the LGD if conditions exist where, in the opinion of the Administrator, fires are of extremely high risk and such a ban would prevent wildfires from occurring"
- On August 25, 2025, the status of wildfire No061 changed from "out of control" to "under control"
- On September 4, 2025, the 30-day extension of the SoLE for wildfire No061 expired

DECISION

The Administrator revokes the temporary burning ban, no burning restrictions in effect after September 4, 2025.
