
Required Action: Declare a State of Local Emergency (SoLE) for the wildfire (Fire NO061) burning in the LGD.

Background Information:

- On July 5, 2025, the Administrator was notified by Municipal and Northern Relations that a wildfire was burning within the LGD approximately 6 km from the City of Thompson. The City's Fire Services were already working on fighting the fire.
- On July 6, 2025, the Administrator reached out to the City Manager to offer support.
- On July 7, 2025, to align with the City of Thompson decision, as it is anticipated the City will declare a state of local emergency, and with the support of Municipal and Northern Relations, the LGD will also declare a state of local emergency as work continues to control the wildfire in the LGD.
 - The Administrator was notified that preventative measure has been and continue to be taken, including a vegetation burn. Areas being targeted are the ski area near the airport, train stations and river pumphouse.
 - the LGD is encountering wildfire that requires prompt action to prevent harm or damage to the safety, health or welfare of persons and property located within the boundaries of the LGD of Mystery Lake.

DECISION

The Administrator, pursuant to section 11(1) of The Emergency Measures Act, declares that a State of Local Emergency exists, from this 7th day of July, 2025 to the 6th day of August, 2025, for wildfire (Fire number NO061) burning in the LGD, approximately 11 km from the City of Thompson effecting 5900 hectares.
